| Day 1      | Arrive Auckland – Private Transfer to your accommodation – relax, take it easy, later take a walk to the Sky Tower and if the night is clear take a ride up to the observatory see the beautiful Auckland cityscape  |
| Day 2      | This is truly a relaxed day with no agenda of any kind and yours to completely enjoy. Auckland has a vibrant Central Business District (CBD) and much to explore within the CBD and you could spend a bit time wandering around the CBD. Take a walk down to the Viaduct and the Ferry Terminal and walk along the Viaduct and see first hand why Auckland is called the “City of Sails”.  |
| Day 3      | After breakfast its time to pick up your rental car or your Luxury Bus will pick you up for your trip to Waitomo Glowworm Caves and then on to Rotorua. You will go on a guided tour of the world famous Waitomo Glowworm Caves including an underground boat ride viewing the millions of Glowworms on the cavern roof. Tonight you will check in to your chosen accommodation in Rotorua |

| Day 4  | This morning its time to go to Te Puia Thermal Reserve for the song & dance show of Maori culture, see Pohutu Geyser, Kiwi Birds and boiling mud pools. Then onward to Rainbow Springs to see New Zealand's trout, birds and wildlife before continuing to the famous Agrodome for the Sheep Show featuring sheep dog demonstrations and sheep shearing. Afternoon is yours to do what you please. |
| Day 5  | Say farewell to this thermal landscape as you make your way to Rotorua airport for your flight to Queenstown (Alpine Resort of New Zealand and many say its even prettier than Switzerland)– Please note the airfare is not included   |
| Day 6  | A Scenic Cruise amidst majestic landscape is today's agenda. Milford Sound – 8 <sup>th</sup> Wonder of the World as declared by Rudyard Kipling –is a stunning Fiord carved by glacial erosion surrounded by looming mountains and cascading waterfalls. This is the location of your Cruise. The drive to the Fiord is itself a treat.  |
| Day 7  | Another day of pure relaxation with just a gentle ride on the Gondola to Bob's Peak (very close to town center) from where you view Queenstown as a bird sees and also see much of Central Otago and on a clear day you might even be able to see Mount Cook.  |
| Day 8  | Time to make your way northward through Central Otago plains, following the shores of several lakes including Lake Pukaki for a stop over at Mount Cook (standing over 12000 feet) followed with a visit to "Church of Good Shepherd" on the shore of Lake Tekapo before you finally reach Christchurch.   |
| Day 9  | Christchurch has an old world English charm to it and is best seen with a morning tour that traverses across the essential parts of this charming town   |
| Day 10 | Time to bid adieu to this beautiful land with a promise of coming back for more. Don't forget to drop of your car at Christchurch Airport or private transfer if you had opted for the luxury coach program. SAFE TRAVELS  |

**RENTAL VEHICLE OPTIONS & INFORMATION:**

1. Toyota Corolla (compact) is the default car for all three travel class
2. All vehicles come with standard Collision Damage Waiver
3. For Peace of Mind we recommend you opt for Total Collision Damage Waiver
  - a. Price varies depending on the type of vehicle hired
4. Airport Pick and Ferry Pick if any are included and varies according to airport/ferry and vehicle rental company
5. Rental Vehicle considered are from Hertz, Thrifty & Go Rentals
6. All rental vehicles are subject to availability
7. If primary driver and/or any driver is under 25 there will be additional charge
8. Fuel, Parking, Road & Toll and Additional Driver charges if any are not included and is the responsibility of the hiring guest
9. Add \$3 per day for an Intermediate Sedan like Toyota Camry or similar
10. Add \$5 per day full sized sedan such as Toyota Aurion 3.5L or similar - V6 engine
11. Add \$55 per day for a mid sized 4WD SUV like Toyota RAV 4 Or similar
12. Add \$65 per day for Full Size SUV like Toyota Highlander or similar – 3.5L to 4.0L AWD
13. Add \$75 per day for Premium SUV Toyota Prado – 3.0L – up to 7 guests can be seated

#### **SPECIAL NOTE FOR CHILDREN:**

- 1. Seat in Coach:**
  - a. Children under age of 12 travelling with two adults sharing existing bedding may travel at **50% of normal adult cost**
  - b. Children under age of 12 travelling with two adults requiring additional bedding may travel at **67% of normal adult cost**
- 2. Self Drive:**
  - a. Children under 12, who share a room and existing bedding with two adults, will not be subject to room costs, however any meals such as breakfasts that form part of our programs will attract 50% of adult cost
  - b. Children under 12 who share a room with two adults and requires additional bedding will be priced as triple share on adult triple share cost
- 3. Sightseeing, experiences and other activity providers:**
  - a. Child price and age of child varies widely from these providers and the same will be given on request. We have given the child cost in each of our highly recommended options below

1. Price is valid for travel dates between April 1, 2015 and June 30, 2015
2. All prices are per guest on Twin Share basis



- a. Single, Triple and Multi Share prices are available on request
3. Price is inclusive of 15% New Zealand GST (Goods & Services Tax)
4. All bookings must be made as follows:
  - a. Booking must be confirmed **60 days** prior to actual date of arrival
  - b. **25%** of the price must be made at the time of booking confirmation
    - i. **If booking is made within 45 days from date of arrival – 100% payment is required at time of confirmation**
  - c. Balance **75%** the price to be remitted **20 working days** prior to date of arrival
  - d. Please note if full payment is not received we will be forced to cancel all reservations held under your name
  - e. If program is cancelled prior to making full payment we will refund your booking amount less 10% of the program price for service charges
  - f. All applicable bank and credit card services fees are to your account either during payment or refund
  - g. If program is cancelled after making full payment and is 72 hours before actual date of arrival the service charge fee will be 25% of the program price
  - h. If program is cancelled within 48 hours of arrival date there will be no refund
5. All experiences are provided by our experience partners
6. For any reason the scheduled experience is cancelled by the provider or postponed due to unsuitable conditions
  - a. They will try to reschedule a suitable alternate time failing which a refund for the specific experience will be made
